Child Protection Policy Statement

The Society is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children and young people.

We do this by:

- Recognising that all children have the right to freedom from abuse.
- Ensuring that all our volunteers are carefully selected and accept responsibility for helping to prevent abuse of children in their care.
- Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of abuse, and providing parents and children with the opportunity to voice any concerns they may have.
- Appointing a Child Protection Officer who will take specific responsibility for child protection and act as a main contact point for parents, children, and outside agencies.
- Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to the Child Protection Officer or the appropriate external authorities.
- Routinely review the effectiveness of our Child Protection Policy and activities.
